Service

Jamestown College students are never far from an opportunity to serve others. As you can see in the following examples, service is incorporated into courses, organizations, and athletics.

During **New Student Orientation**, groups of students spend time on service projects in the community of Jamestown in order to get acquainted with the community and the many opportunities to serve.

Teams visit area churches to organize worship services, teach Sunday School, and do mission work. Groups have also traveled to Guatemala to work for the God's Child Project.

Jamestown College is a National Association for Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) **Champions of Character** Program Center. Jimmie athletes reach out to the community through camps, volunteering, and service projects.

Building 28, the College's Habitat for Humanity chapter, participates in Spring Break trips to build homes for deserving families. Past destinations are West Virginia, Texas, Mississippi, and Florida.

Students of Service, or SOS, is an organization whose mission is to involve all students in campus and community service while developing quality leaders and citizens, increasing character, and promoting life-long dedication to service. Each year, SOS collects gifts and school supplies to fill shoeboxes for Operation Christmas Child.

Students in the **Character in Leadership** program organize and carry out group service projects as a part of their coursework toward their minor in leadership.
